

## Dale O'Rouke Memorial Scholarship

The Dale O'Rouke Memorial Scholarship was established in 2004 to honor Retired Colonel Alan Dale O'Rouke. "Coach" O'Rouke devoted 32 years teaching at North Gwinnett High School and Lanier Middle School. He also served proudly in the U.S. Georgia Army National Guard and was a veteran of Desert Storm. His life and career are proudly remembered in this memorial scholarship.

This scholarship, in the amount of \$500, is awarded annually to a graduating North Gwinnett High School Senior through the North Gwinnett Schools Foundation. Criteria for selection include the following:

Applicant must:

- ❖ Be a North Gwinnett High School Senior, scheduled to graduate
- ❖ Submit a complete written application with all required documentation
- ❖ Grade Point Average and financial need will be considered
- ❖ Participation in ROTC will be taken into consideration but is not required to apply

Instructions for applicants:

- ❖ Complete ALL information on application
- ❖ Attach a current sealed copy of student's official transcript
- ❖ Attach a copy of college acceptance letter(s) if available
- ❖ Return all forms and information to Ms. Blackwell in the Counseling Office by **March 4, 2011**
- ❖ Incomplete or late applications will not be considered
- ❖ Award amount may vary from year to year but will not be less than \$500.00

Scholarship award money may be used for tuition, room and board, and required school expenses such as textbooks, computers, etc. Payment will be made jointly to student and the college or university of attendance. Copies of college acceptance letters must be provided to the Foundation before payment can be made. In the event the student has not received notification of acceptance at the time of the scholarship award, the money will be held until acceptance has been confirmed. In the event the student does not attend college as planned, the student will forfeit the award and is responsible for the reimbursement to the Foundation of any award monies not expended.

The Dale O'Rouke Memorial Scholarship is presented annually at the NGHS Honors Night Ceremony.

The O'Rouke Family reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship criteria or guidelines at any time.
